YOUR FAITH, THIS WEEK

TWENTY-SEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

The Suitable Partner

Gospel: Mark 10:2-16

"They are no longer two but one flesh."

More Catholics have been lost over the matter of divorce than just about any other issue. Jesus is clear about his stand, derived from Genesis. But both the teachings of Moses and the actions of the church have sometimes wavered on this issue. Jesus says two lives joined by God cannot be taken apart. Yet we stand by and watch marriages crumble every day.

Two people contract a marriage for a variety of efficient reasons: to legitimate a sexual union, to beat loneliness, insecurity, financial solvency, to please someone else. When the holes in the contract appear, after a year or five or forty, people head for the doors and that's it. Many of those relationships should end and few of us doubt it. So the church's unyielding stance, borrowed from Jesus, can seem unrealistic.

Annulment is one way the church has found to say: These two lives did not come together for a holy purpose to begin with, in the way Jesus speaks of or the teaching of the church intends. It has to be a deliberate partnership inspired by the love of God and nourished by fidelity. It has to include the element of mutual forgiveness. Otherwise, in the eyes of the Catholic Church, what is lost by divorce is not a sacrament at all.

Questions for Reflection

- * Name three lessons you have learned in love, whether with a spouse, child, parent or friend. How do these reflect the beautiful plan of love in Genesis?
- * Jesus, your brother, is coming to spend the weekend with you. What is in your heart that you want to share with him?
- * How has your life been touched by divorce? Who has shown you the love "joined by God" that Jesus calls us to, and how?

Action Response

Identify those relationships in your life that are "suitable partnerships" of love and faith. Think of family members or others in your community, parish, or circle of friends, with whom you are joined by God to bring love into the world.

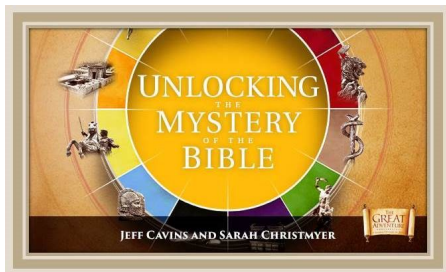

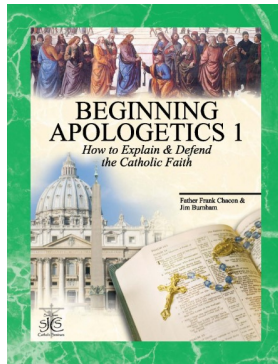

Are you expecting? Prepare before your bundle of joy arrives!

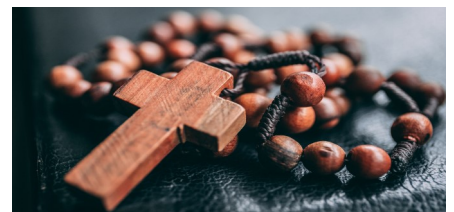
Do you have a child you wish to have Baptized? Don't put off having your child receive the Gift of Grace!
