Lessons and Carols is a liturgy of Scripture and song that dates to the late 19th century. In this service, we listen to seven Scripture lessons that recount the Fall, the promise of a Messiah as foretold by the prophets, and the Incarnation. Each lesson is followed by a carol or hymn that reflects on the lesson's message, and a brief prayer. 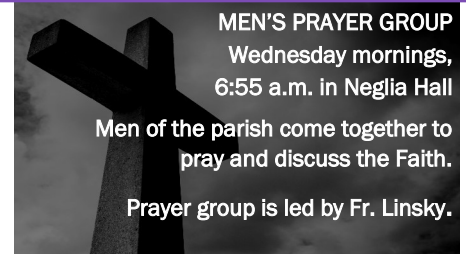

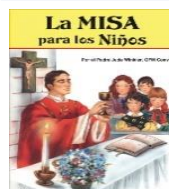
