Why Giving Matters: A Family's Testimony

Tem Miles and his wife Cassie have been members of The Basilica of Saint Peter for 12 years and before they became parents, they knew they wanted to send their children to Saint Peter's Catholic School. Today they have three daughters, two of whom are currently enrolled at the school.

A few months after the birth of their first daughter they found out she had suffered several strokes when she was in utero. They soon after received the news that their first born had cerebral palsy, and their lives changed forever.

Cassie had to give up her law career to become a full-time caregiver for their daughter, and Tem took on the responsibility of providing for his family by working multiple jobs. Like many of our Saint Peter's families, the Miles family makes many sacrifices to give their children the gift of a Catholic Education. Thanks to the generosity of the parishioners of Saint Peter's, the school was able to provide them, and 40 other families, tuition assistance to help with the cost of tuition this school year. Every dollar we receive for the Tuition Assistance Fund goes to help make tuition more affordable for families like the Miles.

The students of Saint Peter's Catholic School are provided a safe and secure, God-centered environment to learn and grow. Advent Lessons and Carols Sunday, December 16th at 7:30 PM

Lessons and Carols is a liturgy of Scripture and song that dates to the late 19th century. In this service, we listen to seven Scripture lessons that recount the Fall, the promise of a Messiah as foretold by the prophets, and the Incarnation. Each lesson is followed by a carol or hymn that reflects on the lesson's message, and a brief prayer. Through our experience of sacred Word and music, the story of the coming of Christ gradually unfolds and deepens our understanding of God's message of love and redemption.



The Octave before Christmas and the O Antiphons

an Ancient Advent Tradition December 17th—23rd

The Octave before Christmas is December 17th-23rd. **O Antiphons** are seven responses that are sung or recited to introduce the canticle of Mary (The Magnificat) at evening prayer the Octave before Christmas. The antiphons are based on Isaiah's prophecies and refer to the different ancient titles given to the Messiah. Each begin with the exclamation "O" and each ends with a plea for the Messiah to come. A wonderful way to focus on the "reason for the season" or to help put "Christ back into Christmas" is to Pray the Antiphons during the Octave of Christmas. In the back of the church you'll find a helpful booklet with the Antiphons, scripture references and prayers to assist in this prayer form during the Octave.



Las Posadas December 16th-24th

The Posadas re-enact Joseph and Mary's difficult journey to Bethlehem and search for shelter for Christ's birth. There is a procession of adults and children with music that accompanies a couple dressed like Joseph and Mary, traveling to three houses each night asking for shelter. The third house receives them, and there is prayer and reflection. Then the feast continues with foods, music, fireworks, piñata, etc. The "Posadas" allow us a glimpse of Joseph and Mary's feelings at not finding a place for Jesus to be born. But also their joy for the New Born king. Let us in a joy-prayerful spirit, follow the example of the immigrant Holy Family of Nazareth, who trusted amidst their suffering that God would never abandon them.

On Saturday, December 1st, **130 children and youth** gathered in the Bernardin Center and parish school for a day filled with service and activities focused on the special days, themes and events that make up the Advent season.

The children learned so much!

They heard about God sending his messengers to us and how they can follow Mary's example of **saying YES to God out of love, obedience and faithfulness!**

They made an **Advent Mat** to take home, to help them focus on Hope, Peace, Joy and Love each week of Advent.

They learned about **Our Lady of Guadalupe**, the patroness of the Americas, and heard the story of Juan Diego. The children made a two-sided ornament of Juan Diego and Our Lady of Guadalupe as well as paper flowers to bring to the parish celebration on December 12th.

They spent time **making a joyful noise** as they sang songs of Advent.

They watched the movie *The Star* and heard the nativity story through the eyes of the animals. They also heard the message that even if we choose to do something wrong **we can change and choose to follow Jesus**. The children made a stain glass tissue star to remind them to follow Christ.

Middle School Youth (6th Grade) had a day packed with faith, service, fun and fellowship.

They **served our parish** by stuffing inserts into the weekly bulletin and by washing the windows of the Bernardin Center to help prepare our facilities for Christmas. They participated in a retreat focused on the themes of Advent and **made chaplets**, one to keep and one to give away. They had fun as they played a **trivia game about the Season of Advent**. And of course their was time for **food and fellowship**.



Senior High Youth (9th-12th Grades) had a day of service and reflection.

They **mentored younger children** as assistants in the activity centers and lunch time. The other half of the day was spend in service, **making and decorating cookies** to be given to a local charity to distribute to our street neighbors, adding **prayer notes** to each package.

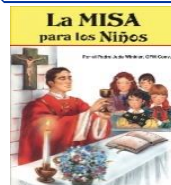
