

The Christmas Season

We all know that the secular Christmas season begins earlier and earlier each year and seems to end once the presents are unwrapped. The liturgical season of Christmas, however, begins with the vigil Masses on Christmas Eve and concludes on the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord (January 13th, this year). During this season, we celebrate the birth of Christ into our world and into our hearts, and reflect on the gift of salvation that is born with him...including the fact that he was born to die for us.



Sunday, January 6th The Epiphany of the Lord

The Epiphany of Our Lord is the Christian feast observed on January 6th. The word "epiphany" comes from the Greek epiphainen, a verb that means "to shine upon," "to manifest," or "to make known." Thus, the feast of the Epiphany celebrates the many ways that Christ has made Himself known to the world, mainly the three events that manifested the mission and divinity of Christ: the visit of the Magi (Matthew 2:1-12), the baptism of Jesus (Mark 1:9-11), and the miracle at Cana (John 2:1-11). The visit of the Magi is emphasized on Epiphany Day, and Christ's baptism is celebrated the first Sunday that follows.


