From the Rector's Desk:

It is with sadness and disappointment that I announce Dr. Andrew Kotylo will depart Saint Peter's in early February, 2019, to begin a new position in Chestnut Hill, Pennsylvania. Dr. Kotylo informs me this is his "dream job" and we wish him every joy and success in his new endeavor. I am grateful for the musical gifts he has shared with us during his time here, drawing all of us closer to God in the sacred liturgy.



Practically speaking, recruiting for the position of Organist/Choirmaster in the middle of the year presents a challenge to us. An announcement of the position has been submitted to three primary organizations to include the Institute of Sacred Music at Yale University, the American Guild of Organists and the National Association of Pastoral Musicians. I am encouraged that we have already received several highly qualified résumés. While we search for the right candidate, we shall also consider seeking an interim to bridge any gap we may encounter.

We take music at Saint Peter's very seriously.

Therefore, I encourage your prayers as we embark on seeking an exceptionally qualified talent and person of faith to lead our music ministry.

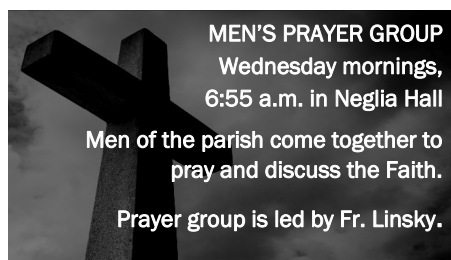

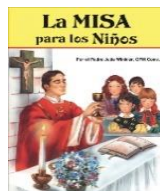
