Be Opened!

Gospel: Mark 7:31-37

"He has done everything well!"

Jesus goes into Gentile territory and brings his message to those who have no share in Israel's God or heritage. Evidently they had advance notice of his accomplishments, because they bring out to him a man who might otherwise have been hidden away. Jesus senses the man's discomfort in front of the crowd, perhaps, because he draws him aside and performs a healing. But the crowds are not about to allow this quiet miracle to remain quiet. What they had heard about Jesus is true: He does all things well.

As in our own time, we often hear the reactions of the crowd, but not the more private response of the individual. I want to gather up all those who were healed by Jesus and ask them, apart from the roar of the crowd, "What has happened to you? How has this changed you? What will you do now?" We know that crowds are fickle. They shout for Jesus today and against him tomorrow. Their astonishment is a passing thing. But what happens inside the person touched intimately by Jesus is another story. This is the story that remains largely untold in the Gospels. It is the story we can tell in the unfolding of our own conversion.

Questions for Reflection

- * What part of your life resembles a desert? How might God cause that place to bloom and become a holy way?
- * Who is favored in your community? Who is despised or overlooked?
- * Imagine you are the deaf and impeded one called to be opened by Jesus. Explain what has happened to you. How has this changed you? What will you do now?

Action Response

Think of one marginalized group or individual in your community who might benefit from your welcome. Resolve to be more inclusive and respectful in your dealings with all who seek a place in the human community.

Attention: Basilica Access During the Week

Many of you are aware that the front doors to our Basilica have normally been unlocked to the public during regular church office hours. Given the current difficulties facing the Catholic Church and the animus that some have expressed, we believe it prudent that people wishing access to the Basilica during working hours for prayer and meditation be let in by our receptionist at the entrance to the Cardinal Bernardin Center to the right of the front door of the church. The exception to this policy will be for the half-hour preceding and following the daily Mass. Appropriate signage will be placed on or by the front door indicating this. Thus, the front doors of the Basilica will be unlocked during the following weekday schedule:

Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday: 11:30 - 1:00

Wednesday: 8:00 - 10:00 a.m.

Arrangements will also be made to accommodate other scheduled liturgical events. Naturally, the front doors of the basilica will be unlocked for all weekend Masses and confession.

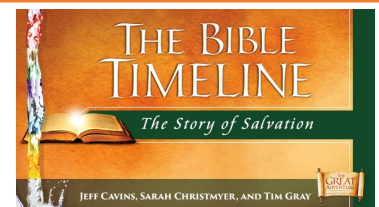

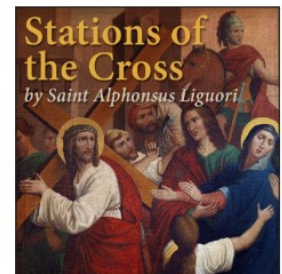
