TWENTY-SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Act on this Word

Gospel: Mark 7:1-8, 14-15, 21-23

You disregard God's command and cling to human tradition.

The battle between Jesus and the Pharisees is about anything but hygiene. Jesus is not opposed to washing your hands before meals, or washing the dishes (sorry, kids). Jesus is protesting empty rituals of purification that have no deeper significance.

We all have ways of washing our hands of the guilt we share. We tell little white lies that leave no tracks. We put people down and say, "Just kidding." We don't vote or get involved in politics because it is too messy. Like Pilate, we wash our hands of unpleasant responsibilities, and believe we are clean.

Run of the mill wicked designs come out of hearts that seem quite neat and orderly to the eye. Lots of churchgoing folk harbor malice in their hearts. And shouldn't this be a cause for our concern, when Jesus tells us every sin begins in our hearts?

Questions for Reflection

- * Christian practice has been to call ourselves sinners while knowing we are the saints of God. Which name are you least comfortable with? How do you know yourself to be both sinner and saint?
- * How do you put actions to the faith you profess at home, at work, in the community?
- * Examine the contents of your heart. What there is harmful to your discipleship? How can you empty what is not pure from your heart?

Action Response

Time to act on the word. Who are today's "widows and orphans," some forgotten group in your community or society at large? Contribute from your time, concern and resources to the poor little ones of God.

Attention: Basilica Access During the Week

Many of you are aware that the front doors to our Basilica have normally been unlocked to the public during regular church office hours. Given the current difficulties facing the Catholic Church and the animus that some have expressed, we believe it prudent that people wishing access to the Basilica during working hours for prayer and meditation be let in by our receptionist at the entrance to the Cardinal Bernardin Center to the right of the front door of the church. The exception to this policy will be for the half-hour preceding and following the daily Mass. Appropriate signage will be placed on or by the front door indicating this. Thus, the front doors of the Basilica will be unlocked during the following weekday schedule:

Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday: 11:30 - 1:00

Wednesday: 8:00 - 10:00 a.m.

Arrangements will also be made to accommodate other scheduled liturgical events. Naturally, the front doors of the basilica will be unlocked for all weekend Masses and confession.

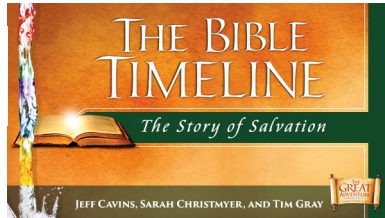

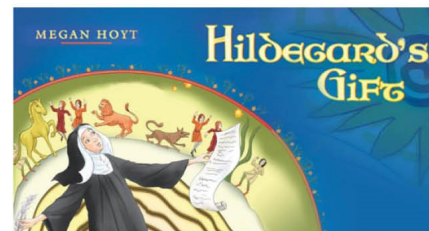
